What is Commingled Recycling?

Commingled recycling also known as single stream or single sort recycling refers to a system in which all paper fibers, plastics, metals, and other containers are mixed together into one bin or roll can by the customer, instead of being sorted separately.

Many materials can be recycled using this method, but there are some that cannot: Glass, oil, yard waste, appliances, and furniture to name a few.

Use the following instructions to make sure that your recycling efforts are successful.



Commingled Recycling Instructions

DO NOT PLACE ANYTHING IN YOUR CAN THAT IS NOT MENTIONED HERE

Call your garbage hauler for other recycling options or further instructions



Flattened Cardboard Boxes

Flatten all boxes, do NOT cut up



Pop Cans and Food Cans

Empty and rinse all cans. No lids
(No food or liquid residue) DO NOT FLATTEN



Plastic Bottles, Jugs and Tubs

(#1-6 ONLY) Empty and rinse all containers, No lids
(No food or liquid residue) DO NOT FLATTEN



Paper Boxes and Dairy Cartons

Empty and rinse all containers,
(No food or liquid residue) no cups, to-go boxes



Newspapers, Magazines, Junk Mail, Office Paper, Paper Scrap

Clean paper only, envelopes ok. Shredded paper must be bagged. No cups, plates, napkins, towels or to-go boxes

FLATTENED CARDBOARD BOXES

- Cardboard
- Grey board
- Flattened
- Unwaxed
- Do not cut up



PLASTIC

- Jugs
- Tubs
- Bottles



PAPER

- Newspaper
- Magazines
- Phone books
- Junk mail
- Paperback books
- Shredded paper in paper sack



POP CAN & FOOD CANS

- Food & beverage containers
- Empty and rinsed
- No Lids
- Do not flatten
- Clean aluminum foil rolled into a ball



PAPER BOXES & DAIRY CARTONS

- Milk cartons
- To-go boxes
- Empty rinse all containers
(No food or liquid residue)



HOW TO PREPARE COMMINGLED RECYCLING

#1 RULE: ALL RECYCLING MUST BE CLEAN



#2 RULE: REMOVE AND DISPOSE OF CAPS AND LIDS

- Metal can lids may be left attached and pushed into the can



#3 RULE: FLATTEN ALL CARDBOARD AND PAPER

- All other items must retain their shape for proper sorting
- Shredded paper must be contained in a paper bag with the top closed tightly
